



HOW ARE STUDENTS BEING RECOGNIZED?

Please watch for an invitation to your child's celebration!



What is Fish?

Fish! is a philosophy based on the Pike Place Fish Market in Seattle, Washington. This philosophy is based on the following four principles: **Play, Be There, Choose Your Attitude & Make Their Day.** Implementation of these four principles into our school culture is making a difference by strengthening relationships among staff, students and parents.

What does Fish! look like at Salk?

Play

“Anything can be boring if you make it boring. Anything can be fun if you make it fun!”

Teachers and students are finding ways to make their classrooms and our school a fun place to learn. For example, each classroom has their own *Pete the Perch* to toss around.

“Playing” in this way energizes creativity and problem-solving abilities.



Be There

“It’s about who you’re being while you’re doing what you’re doing.”

Teachers and students are making a conscious choice to pay attention, listen, look and actually hear what others are saying. It requires thinking about and taking responsibility for how you react and how you treat others. This principle influences everything we do at school, especially “who we are being” while teaching and learning.



Choose Your Attitude

“When you look for the best, you will find possibilities you never imagined.”

Everyone at Salk is attempting to “choose their attitude” each and every day. Choosing our attitude allows us to focus on the positives and to have positive effects on everyone around us. Your view determines everything. We may not like every book, assignment, or subject, but choosing our attitude can make the most out of every day.
