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To Parents/Guardians of FHS Online Learning Students:

I am pleased that your child has chosen to participate in the FHS Online Learning Academy. Over the summer months, teachers have been developing online courses that combine classroom instruction with online learning for the students to experience. All of the teachers have received training to help them prepare and implement their hybrid courses.

At Fraser High School, we chose to develop our own online courses as opposed to purchasing pre-made courses from a for-profit company. This ensures that our online classes maintain the rigor of and meet the same standards as our traditional face-to-face courses. Hybrid courses use a blended learning environment where the student spends part of their time in the classroom learning directly from the teacher in the same manner as a face-to-face class and part of their time completing work online. Please know that the students are never left on their own. Our teachers consistently contact students via online resources and provide direct instruction in the classroom. This insures that there is no difference in rigor or teacher interaction between our Hybrid courses and our face-to-face courses. As a result of developing our own courses, online students get the same level of academic excellence as all students at Fraser High School. In the Online Learning Academy, your student will learn about good digital citizenship and netiquette, how to manage his/her time, and preparation for online courses in post-secondary education.

We are entering our ninth year of the online learning program and are discovering new ways to teach our students every day. With our one-to-one MacBook initiative, students will be able to access their online courses anywhere they have wireless Internet access. This will give them more flexibility in when, where, and how they complete course work. I am excited about how this technology has already transformed and will continue to allow us to adapt our hybrid courses as well as our traditional courses and school.
