

AHERA (Asbestos Hazard Emergency Act)

The Environmental Protection Agency has determined that airborne asbestos fibers can be a health hazard. The Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act 9 (AHERA) was passed in 1986.

District buildings are monitored every six months and inspected every three years to comply with AHERA regulations. The last inspection was completed in 2016. The six month surveillance reports may be viewed at the Operations & Maintenance Building. Each Plan shows Asbestos related work that has occurred in each building.
