QUALIFICATIONS

- 1. Applicant must be a senior with a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.5 and will graduate in the year the application is submitted. (Early College students are eligible to apply after completion of their Early College program of study)
- 2. Student's family member or authorized representative must have been a member in good standing with the Booster club for at least two (2) full years. To be considered a member in good standing, all members must volunteer to work at one (1) FABC-sponsored fundraiser and one (1) concessions, as well as attend two (2) membership meetings during the membership year. Exceptions will be made only for students who have only attended Fraser High School for their senior year if they and their parents meet the qualifications during their senior year.
- 3. If selected, the student must show proof of enrollment, student ID number and school class schedule for current semester into a "qualified" Continuing Education Program (e.g., college, university, trade school).
- 4. Please be advised that any student-athlete receiving a full athletic scholarship upon graduation is <u>not</u> eligible for a Booster Scholarship Award.
