Operations & Maintenance Department Status Report:

Mr. Waters said the final cleaning is wrapping up this week and next and the schools will be ready for students in two weeks. His team installed new gym doors at RMS where they were falling apart. They are also working on some renovations in the art rooms at FHS. The new security buttons are being installed this week at all of the schools. The emergency bags have

been placed in the classrooms. Security film is on the door windows and office windows. Met with Barton Malow last week to talk about the bond projects.

Correspondence: None. Superintendent's Report:

District Updates – Dr. Wozniak told the Board about the opening day events for next week. This year will focus on culture and climate. She also introduced Captain Bisby and Chief Kretzschmar from Fraser Public Safety to discuss the FLOCK system. This is a license plate reading camera system that can help deter crimes. They would like to partner with the district to install three cameras (Garfield and 15 Mile, 15 Mile and Klein and Klein and Garfield). There would be a cost of \$3,000/camera/year to the district. It is only a law enforcement tool; school district officials will not have to access to the information. They will present at the Fraser City Council meeting in September for five additional cameras. Finally, Dr. Wozniak brought up waiving the pay to play fees for athletics for the upcoming school year. Currently, about 25-35% of students' fees are already waived based on family need. The fees generate around \$50,000 a year. This would need board approval yearly.
